
Linkage to Care

- Goal 1: Ensure that HIV positive individuals who are unaware of their status are identified, informed of their status, referred to medical treatment, and linked to care (LTC).
- Goal 2: Identify individuals who know their HIV status but are not in care and inform and link these individuals to care (Linkage to Care).



Retention in Care

 Goal 3: Increase proportion of PLWHA retained and/or reengaged in care (retention/reengagement in care).


